# How to set up your Bark Watch

#### Step 1

# Turn on $\bigcirc$ your Bark Watch

Long press the top right button to power it on.





#### Step 2

Connect the Bark Watch to Wi-Fi

With your phone, scan [6] the QR code that appears on the watch screen

Create an account or log in to manage settings

# Getting to know the buttons



#### How to turn the Bark Watch on and off

Long-press (2+ seconds) the upper side button 1
 to turn on/off the Bark Watch.

#### How to get to the home screen

Short press (less than 2 seconds) the upper side
 button 1 to get to the home screen.

#### How to turn the display on/off

- When you're on the home screen, short pressing the upper side button 1 will turn the display on and off.
- Quickly pressing the upper side button 1 twice will pull up the camera.

#### How to open your contacts screen

 Quickly press the bottom side button 2 twice (2x) to bring up the contacts screen.

#### How to quickly call an emergency contact

- Long-press (2+ seconds) the bottom side button ② to start calling your emergency contacts directly.
- Call the next emergency contact if the first call is not answered within 20 seconds.

#### How to open the emergency/medical ID screen


- Short-press (less than 2 seconds) the bottom side button
  to enter the emergency/medical ID Screen.
- Then, press the **top button** Emergency on the screen to begin calling emergency contacts. The watch will call the next emergency contact if the first call is not answered within 20 seconds.
- Press the **bottom button** on the screen to view important medical information (this info can be updated in the watch settings menu).

#### How to contact 911 with the emergency button

- Short press the **upper side button** 1, then short-press the **bottom side button** 2 twice.
- This will bring up the 911 SOS call screen.
- Swipe right → to call 911.

# Home screen functions

- 1 The Bark Watch has a touch screen.
- 2 Short press (less than 2 seconds) the **upper** side button to get to the home screen.
- Swipe down ↓ from the home screen to get to the quick settings menu.
- Swipe up ↑ from the home screen to see notifications.
- Swipe right → from the home screen to get to app screens.
- 6 Swipe left ← from the home screen to get to app list.
- Swipe right → on any screen to reverse an action or go back to the previous screen.
- 8 Long press (3+ seconds) on the home screen to change the **Watch Face**.



# Accessing apps

### Contacts

Swipe left ← from the home screen and tap contacts.

### Camera

Swipe left ← from the home screen and tap camera or tap the upper side button twice.

### Message

Swipe left ← from the home screen and tap **message** to send/view texts.

## Clock

Swipe left ← from the home screen and tap **clock** to set reminders, tasks, timers or use stopwatch.

### Dialer

Swipe left ← from the home screen and tap **dialer** to get to the phone keypad.

## Gallery

Swipe left ← from the home screen and tap **gallery** to view your pictures or videos.

## Settings

Swipe left ← from the home screen and tap settings.

# How to charge your Bark Watch

- Plug the USB connector 
   into your watch's wall charger and connect the charging block with magnets to the back of the watch.

#### Keep in mind:

- Before using your device, please fully charge ② it for 2 hours.
- Don't let it charge more than 5 hours 🛠 to save battery life.
- Make sure the gold connector pads and magnetic charging pins stay clean.

## **Battery**

The Bark Watch has a non-removable battery . Don't attempt to remove the battery or try to disassemble it as this could result in personal injury, safety hazard, damage to the battery or the device. Trying to remove the battery will void the warranty.

**Note:** Never expose the battery to temperatures **@°** higher than 140°F (60°C).
